Renowned for its legendary robustness, the self-winding SW500 is the quintessential Swiss automatic chronograph movement. The SW500 is characterised by its integrated chronograph mechanism and its multiple functions, which include a 30-minute counter, a 12-hour counter as well as a date display. The custom rotor incorporates the designer's signature and the movement is finished to the highest standard.

Key Features

- Designed by Sir Terence Conran
- Sterling silver buckle cast in an alloy made from an original horseshoe worn by the champion steeplechaser Golden Miller in 1934
- Seven sapphires either side of the caseback reference horseshoe nails. The sapphires are in the racing colours of Golden Miller's owner Dorothy Paget (blue and yellow)
- · One piece dial with banked outer edge
- Bi-Compax chronograph layout reflecting Brooklands timekeepers' stopwatches
- Chronograph counterweight hands mirroring the Brooklands Chronograph Villa clock
- 12-hour timing
- · Concave pushers with grip ring
- Conran Blue crown cap
